ORDINANCE NO. 2004-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FORWARD, BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF FORWARD CODE OF ORDINANCES BY THE ADDITION OF THE REQUIREMENT FOR A ROAD OCCUPANCY PERMIT PRIOR TO ACCESS TO AND OCCUPANCY OF TOWNSHIP ROADS BY DRIVEWAYS AND LOCAL ROADS.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, enacted May 1, 1933, as amended, Section 2317, the Board of Supervisors of Forward Township may prescribe regulations with respect to private driveways and local roads; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the Township of Forward citizens and the traveling public to require a permit for access to township roads;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the Township of Forward as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 21 of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Forward is hereby amended by the addition of Part 3 thereto as follows:

Part 3

Section 3.01. Road occupancy permit required.

Access to and occupancy of highways by driveways and local roads. No driveway, local road or drainage facility or structure shall be constructed or altered within Township road right-of-way and no drainage facility of the Township may be altered or connected onto without first obtaining a permit from the Township.

Section 3.02. PennDOT Standards Adopted.

Title 67, Chapter 441 of the Pennsylvania Code, as amended, is hereby incorporated herein by reference, except where the context thereof would be reasonably substitute the Township for the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation; and procedure for appeals from determinations of the Township which shall be governed by applicable law.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective in five days.
