ORDINANCE NO. 2014-2

AN ORDINANCE OF FORWARD TOWNSHIP PARTIALLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2003-1 SO THAT THE MUNICIPAL CODE ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AUTHORITY IS NO LONGER AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN THE PERMITTING, REGULATION, INSPECTION AND CODE ENFORCEMENT OF ON-LOT SEPTIC SYSTEMS.

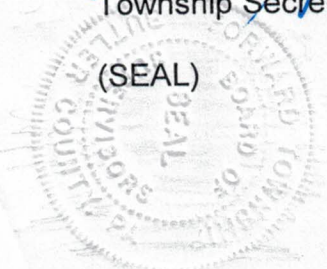
BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, this 9th day of September, 2014, by the Forward Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 2003-1 enacted April 8, 2003, entitled: "An Ordinance of the Township of Forward, Butler County, Pennsylvania, providing for the entering into intergovernmental cooperation with other municipalities of Butler County to establish and maintain the association to administer and enforce the requirements of the building codes of the Township of Forward", is hereby repealed insofar as it delegates the permitting, regulation, inspection and code enforcement of on-lot sewage systems to the Municipal Code Enforcement Agency.
2. The repeal of said portion of the Ordinance shall take place five (5) days after enactment, and it shall be effective at the close of business on December 31, 2014.
3. All other provisions of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
