CALL MEETING TO ORDER:

Chairman Rape called the public hearing to order at 2:01 PM in the small meeting room at the Forward Township Administration Building, 207 Ash Stop Road, Evans City, PA. 16033

NEW BUSINESS:

- Roadmaster Behm requested that the supervisors consider the purchase of blower attachment that would allow the removal of leaves and other debris from the catch basins and drains along the township's roadways.

Chairman Rape made a motion to purchase the blower attachment at a cost of \$5,500 with money being transferred from Act 13. Vice-Chairman Musulin seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

- The supervisors reviewed the township budgets for 2018, 2019, and 2020. They then discussed anticipated revenues and expenses for 2021. The potential effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on the proposed budget were considered.

Vice-Chairman Musulin made a motion to increase the existing wage rate for the current road master, road department employees, and the township secretaries by 2 (two) % for the 2021 calendar year. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Chairman Rape made a motion to approve the Township's 2021 Annual Budget as agreed. Vice-Chairman Musulin seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT:

Vice Chairman Musulin made a motion at 3:35 PM to adjourn the November 19, 2020 special meeting. Supervisor Wilson seconded the motion, motion passed unanimously.
